a. Financial Reports: Jan. 2023

Canon David Francis presented the financial report.

The expected monthly budget percentage is 8.3%. The actual income for January was 10.7%. The actual expenditure percentage is 7.5% with a cash balance for the month of \$15,000.43.

The Tithes for December 2022, minus one church yet to be paid, totaled \$41,663.04 for a total tithe income for 2022 of \$432,156.05, 93% of the approved budget of \$465,350.00.

As you look at the 2023 budget worksheet, you will note that the Restricted Funds Income and Expense section at the bottom of the report has been greatly expanded to allow for better understanding of how those in/out non-budget funds come in and are spent throughout the year.

c. Mission Grant Requests

The subcommittee consists of Bishop Eric Menees, Cn. Dave Francis, Fr. Luke Childs, and Dcn. Leslie Arbegast.

Los Banos has returned the funds (\$30,000) that was granted to them for a Coffee House Ministry; and we have \$10,560 in the budget for Mission and Ministry Grants. So technically we do have \$40,560 for Mission Grants.

We have received our first two grant requests.

Dcn. Leslie Arbegast gave a report on <u>Ascension's (Bakersfield)</u> Mission Grant request. During the last year Ascension in Bakersfield has been going through church growth programs and would like to use 'SEO' Search Engine Optimization to help them narrow down on particular parts of town.

The Subcommittee moved approval of \$1575.

Fr. Luke Childs gave a report on Emmanuel's (Fresno) Mission Grant request. One of Bishop's goals for Emmanuel is to model Multicultural Ministry in the Diocese. Emmanuel is requesting a grant of \$12,000 to fund 'Multicultural Ministry Fellow'. The church is looking to hire Fr. Enrique Melchor (Cuban priest) and provide room and board, and transport cost for 6 months. During these 6 months the resources will be available to Diocese wide as well.
